

Call: Jan. ~ March

- Period is 7 to 10 years. Grant is up to 500 million JPY (3 million EUR).
- This grant aims to enable research groups led by top-level researchers in our country to play a central role in the international network, thereby achieving research results of high scientific value internationally.
- With the participation of postdoctoral fellows and graduate students, the grant seeks to foster researchers who can play leading roles in the international research community in the future

Fostering Joint International Research

国際共同研究強化 Call: July~Sep.

- ➤ Period is 6-12 months. Grant is up to 12 million JPY (75,000 EUR).
- Support for joint international research projects conducted by a KAKENHI grantee in collaboration with researchers at a foreign university or research institute.
- The grant seeks to markedly advance KAKENHI research projects and to foster independent researchers to be internationally competitive.

Home-Returning Researcher Development Research

帰国発展研究

- > Period is up to 3 years. Grant is up to 50 million JPY (320,000 EUR).
- > Support for research by a Japanese researcher with current affiliation abroad who is to be newly appointed at university or research institute in Japan.

- Promotion of international joint research through the establishment of new KAKENHI research category "International Leading Research"




- Through the establishment of KAKENHI new research category "International Leading Research", strongly promoting a support for joint international research with overseas top-level research teams carried out by excellent research teams led by top-level researchers who have achieved very good research results and are connected on international networks.
- Of Moreover, participations of early-career scientists (PDs and graduate students) are the basic requirements for application. By implementing the long term-dispatch to overseas / exchange sessions and providing self-reliance support, fostering excellent early-career scientists who are competent enough in the face of the global academic rivalry.

<Period / Amount>

7 years (extensions granted till 10 years) with support from the Multi-year Fund up until 500 million yen at max




Creating Research Hubs - Core-to-Core Program

A. Advanced Research Networks

- Target: Any country in the world
- ■Objective:
- Promote international collaboration in cutting edge fields by creating world-class research hubs
- · Foster new generations of talented young researchers in Japan and other countries
- ■Grants: Up to JPY 18 million/year
- *Partner institutions are required to cover their own expenses. (cf. international exchange fees, etc.)
- ■Project duration: 5 years

B. Asia-Africa Science Platforms

- ■Target: Asian and/or African countries/ regions
- ■Objective:
- Japanese research institutions take the lead in building research hubs and fostering young researchers to contribute to Asian/African region
- ■Grants: Up to JPY 8 million/year from JSPS
- ■Project duration: 3 years



- ◆ Research Contents: The InRel-NPower project researches high voltage GaN and AIN transistors for application in power electronics, from growing the raw material to packaging and a demonstration of its potential in a final device.
- ◆ Research Period: 3 years
- Research Amount: JPY 60,000,000



ERC Grants (Synergy Grant)

European Research Council (ERC)



Supporting frontier research by researchers (Principal Investigator: PI)

should spend at least 50% of their total working time in an EU Member State

Starting Grant (for young researchers)

Target:

2-7 years of experience since completion of PhD Funding amount:

Up to € 1.5 million for a period of 5 years

Consolidator Grant (for Independent researchers)

Target:

7-12 years of experience since completion of PhD and who want to consolidate their independence

Funding amount:

Up to € 2 million for a period of 5 years

Advanced Grant (for senior researchers)

Target:

who have a track-record of significant research achievements in the last 10 years.

Funding amount:

Up to € 2.5 million for a period of 5

One of this small group of Principal Investigators can be hosted full-time by an institution outside of the EU

Synergy Grant (for team of multiple researchers)

Principal Investigators work together and bring different skills and resources to tackle ambitious research problems

A group of two to maximum four Principal Investigators

Up to a maximum of € 10 million for a period of 6 years (pro rata for projects of shorter duration) Call for proposals: July-Nov.




Human Frontier Science Program (HFSP)



- Fund postdocs to go abroad
- Start-up funds to set up first lab
- Team grants to initiate international collaborations
- Team consist of 2-4 members
- Focus on International collaboration/ Interdisciplinary / Challenging
